

Dome Light User Guide

This guide has been written to help you get the most from your Dome Light. Please ensure that you read this fully as it contains important information on setting up your Dome Light. Failure to follow this advice may result in damage to the Dome Light and invalidate your warranty.

Keep this guide in a safe place for future reference.





Unpacking

- 1. The Dome Light is shipped in specialist packaging, designed to protect it from damage during transport.
- 2. Ensure that Dome Light is carefully removed from the out packaging. Keep the packaging in case the Dome Light needs to be returned.
- 3. The power supply (12V DC 1.5A) will be taped to the unit. This power lead is around 1.5M in length.
- 4. **Warning:** Only use the detachable supply unit provided with this appliance.
- 5. If you find any damage when you unpack you should report it within **7 days** to your supplier.
- 6. If repairs are not completed by Apollo Creative this will void warranty and we will not be held liable for any damage or injury caused.

Setting up

- 1. The Dome Light can either be mounted to the ceiling or wall depending on your requirements.
- 2. Situate the Dome Light slightly away from the end user if placed on the ceiling.
- 3. The Dome Light must be attached to a **solid** wall using fixings appropriate to the construction of the wall.
- 4. Attach the Dome Light using the 4 brackets constructed on the Dome Light itself. Remember to place your power supply appropriately to suit your requirements for installation.
- 5. Ensure that the power supply is sited at an adequate distance from the Dome Light and that there is no tension in the power cable.
- 6. The power cable should never be coiled around the power supply as this may cause it to overheat and malfunction.
- 7. Please use this product with care as rough handling could cause damage to the unit.
- 8. Your dome light is now ready for use.

Potential risks & warnings

- 1. Read and understand all these instructions before using the Dome Light.
- 2. Never stare directly into the middle of the Dome Light when the unit is turned on. LED's emit a large amount of light which could be damaging to the eyes.
- 3. Do not operate the Dome Light with a damaged power cord, or if it has been dropped or damaged.
- 4. Position the power cord so that it will not be tripped over, pulled or come into contact with hot surfaces.
- 5. Always connect the Dome Light source to a grounded outlet.
- 6. To reduce the risk of electrical shock, do not immerse the product in water or other liquids.
- 7. Do not dismantle the Dome Light, contact the supplier or manufacturer if servicing is required. Incorrect assembly can cause electrical shock when the product is used.
- 8. Always unplug the unit from the power socket before cleaning, servicing and when not in use. Never yank the cord to pull the plug from the outlet. Grasp the plug and pull to disconnect.
- 9. This developmental aid appliance can be used by children aged from 8 years and above and persons with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities or lack of experience and knowledge if they have been given supervision or Instruction concerning use of the developmental aid appliance in a safe way and understand the hazards involved.
- 10. Children below this age must be supervised when using this developmental aid appliance. Cleaning and user maintenance shall not be made by children.
