

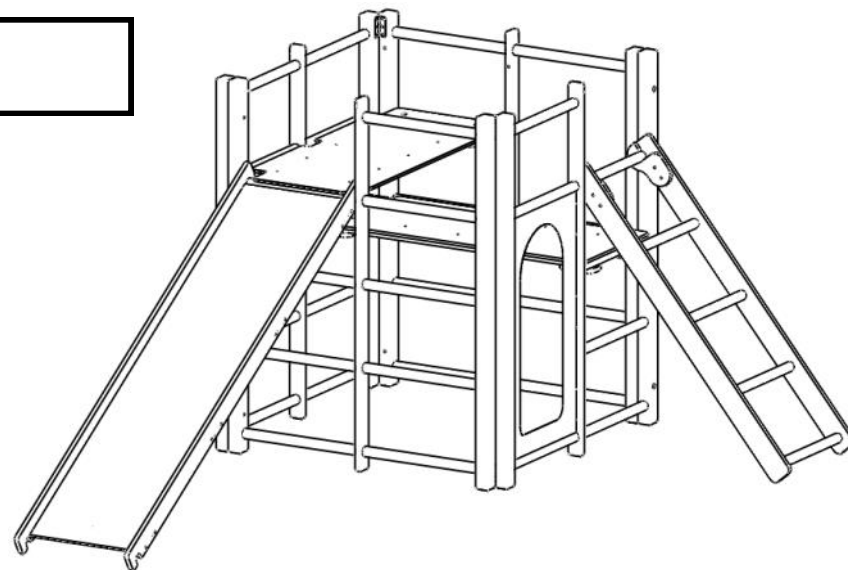

IMPORTANT

PLEASE READ THIS INFORMATION BEFORE CONTINUING

- The activity centre must be assembled by an adult.
- The activity centre is designed for indoor use on a flat surface.
- The activity centre must be positioned to allow a minimum of 1.5 metres of free/clear space around the perimeter of the activity centre.
- Please note that any natural materials (e.g. ply wood) may vary in colour / finish.

SAFETY INSPECTIONS & MAINTENANCE

- Make a routine visual inspection daily before use.
- Check screws & bolts to be sure they remain tight.
- Periodically inspect for cracks, breaks, loose parts, missing parts, and/or malfunctions.
- Remove the product from service when any condition develops which might make operation unsafe.
- Every 1 to 3 months manually check that all connections are tight and all components are functioning.
- Every year perform a thorough safety inspection of all components.
- If equipment is subject to heavy use increase inspection and maintenance as appropriate.
- Use only replacement parts supplied by Findel Education

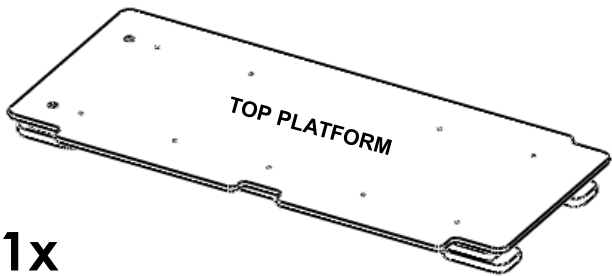

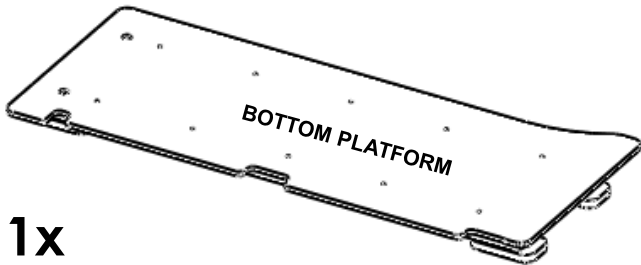
CLEANING

Clean the surface using a slightly damp cloth and if necessary soapy water. Do not use any cleaning product containing alcohol, bleach or other abrasives. 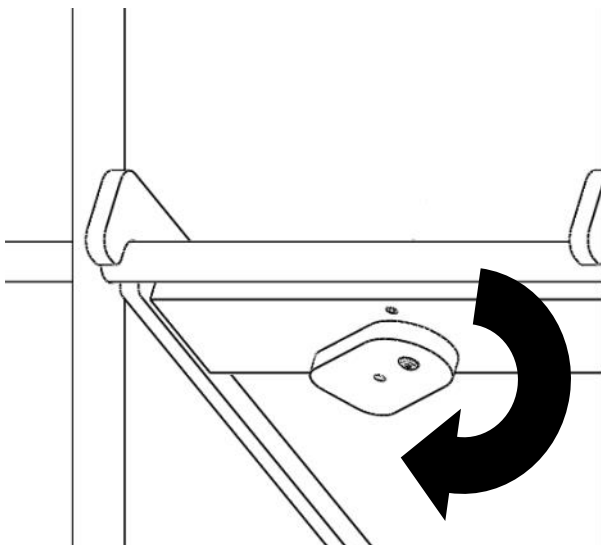


WARNING ! Securing the Slide

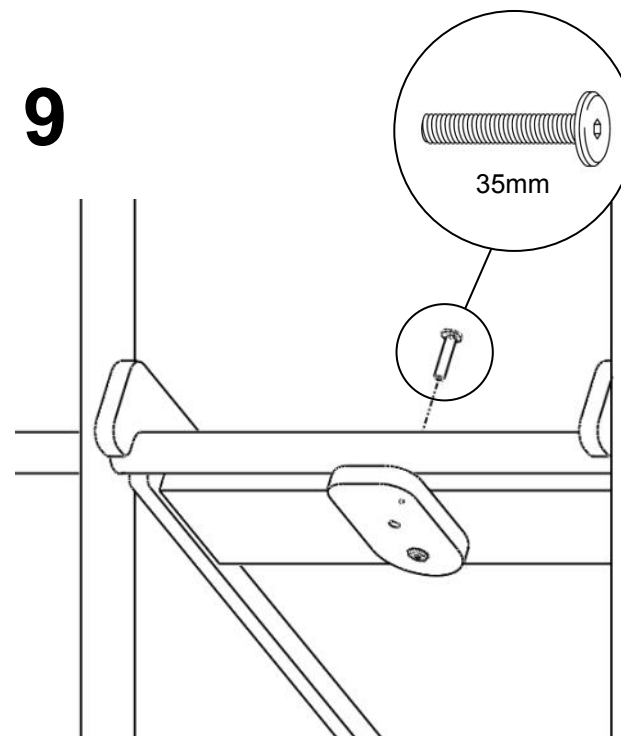
A Slide must always be connected to the frame when the frame is in use. The Slide must only be secured to the frame in the position shown.

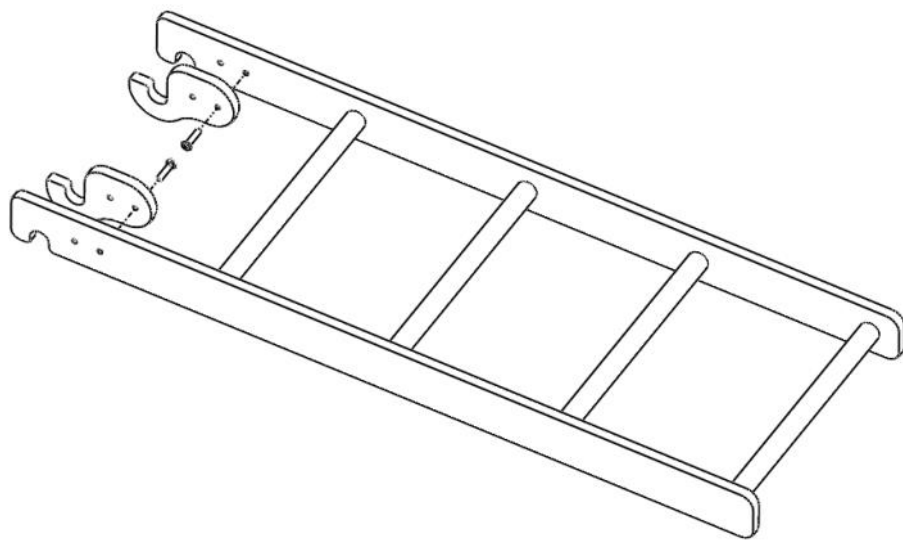


WARNING ! Securing the Slide

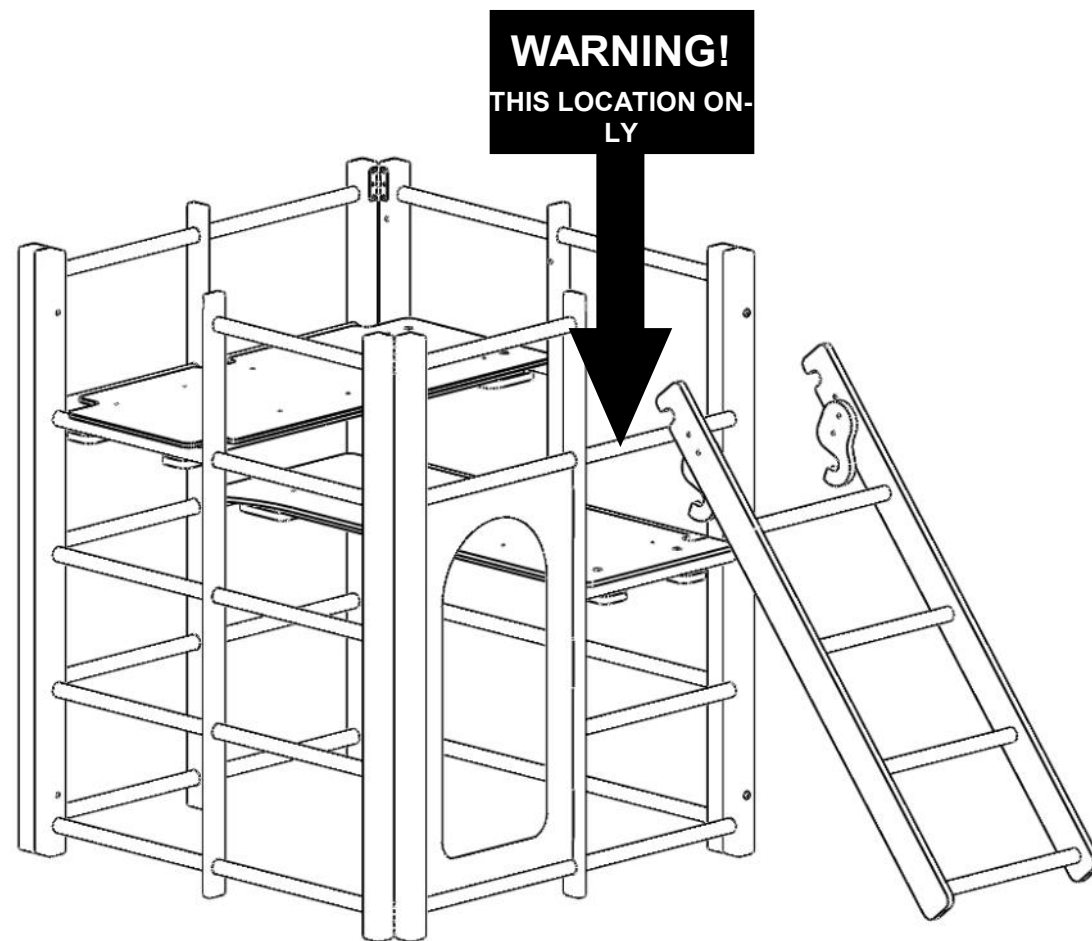

Failure to use and position in this way is in violation of the European safety standards (EN1176) and could result in a child being injured.

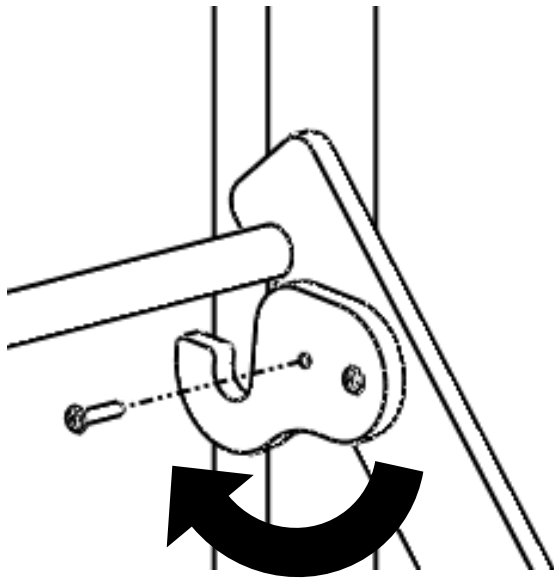

The Ladder must be secured to the frame as illustrated in steps 3.

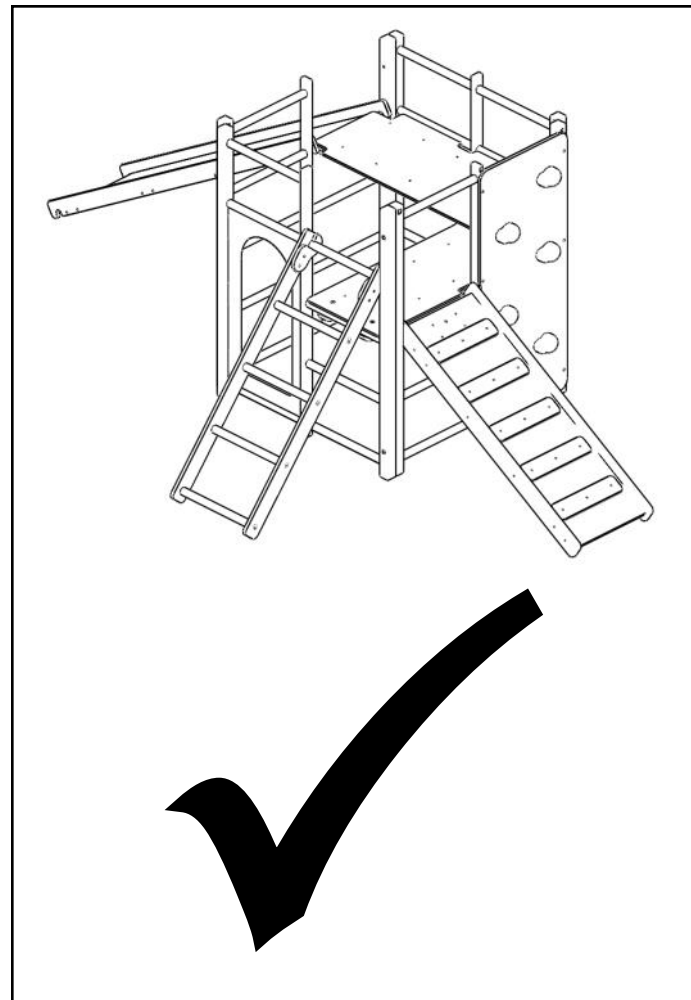
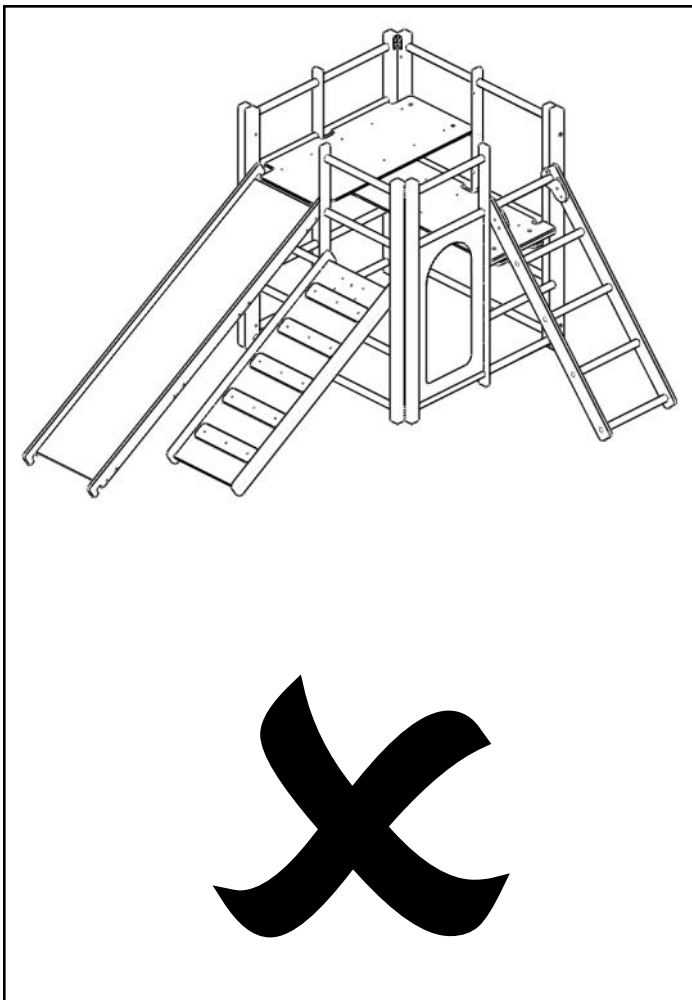
Failure to secure using the supplied bolt is in violation of the European safety standards (EN1176) and could result in the slide detaching in use.



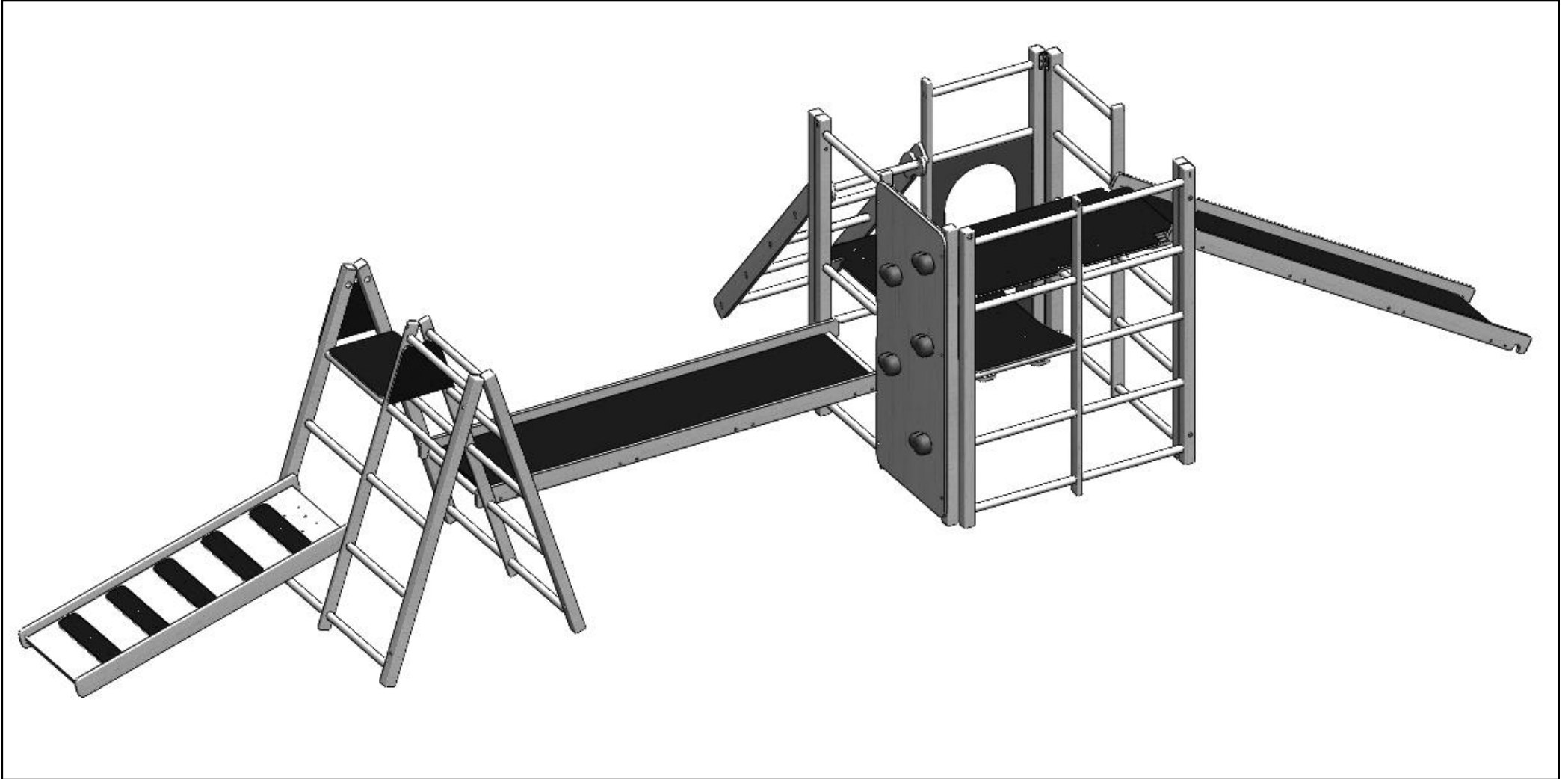
WARNING ! Attaching multiple Accessories
