This **Oxford First Picture Dictionary** is designed to give confidence and support to young readers and writers in using their early dictionary skills. Children can correct their spelling, and can check the way words are used. The text is illustrated by Val Biro, who is immensely popular with children, and his pictures will provide entertainment, fun, and also a useful key to understanding the meaning of words.
