		• Teach grapheme and alliteration caption 'h' happy hippo.
		• <b>Lowercase formation caption</b> : Top to bottom, up to the middle and over.
		• Formation of grapheme - Trace h in the air.
		• <b>Decoding</b> – Explain using mnemonic on page 41.

Children read each others cards then trade and the process repeats itself a few times. Teacher and TAs must try and hear children reading and correct misconceptions or errors.
