The toy and its materials were visually clean and free from infestation.

4.2 Assembly**PASS**

The toy was accompanied by detailed assembly instructions that were considered to be appropriate.

4.7 Edges**PASS**

No accessible sharp edges or hazardous burrs were found.

4.8 Points and metallic wires**PASS**

No technically accessible wires or sharp points were found.

4.16 Heavy immobile toys**PASS**

The toy had a mass of greater than 4.5 kg. It did not tip over when tested to 8.23.2 (stability, heavy immobile toys).

**EN 71-1:2014 Mechanical and physical****5.1 Under 3 years - General requirements****PASS**

The toy itself did not fit inside a small parts cylinder.

The toy had no prohibited removable components.

Soak washing prior to testing is not required by this standard (it is a requirement of EC Directive 2009/48/EC), it was therefore not carried out.

The toy did not produce any prohibited parts that fitted inside a small parts cylinder or accessible sharp edges or accessible sharp points after torque tests, tension tests, drop tests, impact test and compression test. There were no magnets or magnetic components and no wires with a cross section of less than 2 mm in the toy.

The toy did not possess any accessible springs nor any metal points or wires.

The toy was not a large or bulky toy, nor a glued wooden toy, nor did it have glued on plastic decals.

The toy was not intended for children too young to sit up unaided.
